Policy of Non-discrimination

Archbishop Carroll High School does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national or ethnic origin in the administration of its education and admission policies, scholarship or financial aid programs, and athletic or other school-administered programs.

Students applying from Catholic schools in the Archdiocese of Washington:

1. Select Carroll on the Archdiocesan Choice Form to have the completed transcript sent to Carroll.
2. Complete a Carroll admissions application (available online) and submit it to the Admissions Office with a \$25.00 application fee, checks made payable to Archbishop Carroll High School.
3. The Archbishop Carroll Admissions Committee reviews test scores, transcripts and recommendations from the elementary school.
4. Interview with the Admissions Committee.

Students applying from non-Catholic schools:

1. Complete a Carroll admissions application (available online) and submit it to the school with a \$25.00 application fee, checks made payable to Archbishop Carroll High School.
2. Make arrangements with the Catholic Schools Office (Archdiocese of Washington) to take the High School Placement Test (HSPT).
3. Submit results from the HSPT to Carroll. Submit a request to your middle school to send a complete transcript and standardized test scores from the past two years to Carroll.
4. Submit three recommendations: one from a current school administrator or counselor, one from your current Math teacher, and one from your current English teacher.
5. Interview with the Admissions Committee.



The Admissions Office must have ALL of the above items, including your application fee, in order to consider your application.

Tuition and Fees

Archbishop Carroll High School offers a competitive, college-preparatory education.

Tuition for the 2011-2012 school year is \$10,535. Various options for tuition payments are available. The total of additional fees range from \$250-\$300. A non-refundable registration fee is due no later than two weeks after notification of acceptance.

Financial Aid and Scholarships

Archdiocese of Washington — You must complete the PSAS form to apply for Archdiocesan tuition assistance. Visit www.catholicschoolswork.org or call 301-853-5356 for the form and more information.

Academic scholarships — Merit scholarships are available for incoming 9th graders. The admissions committee will review grades, test scores, teacher recommendations and essays for qualified applicants. Recipients will be notified at the time of acceptance.
