

## DRESS CODE

Archbishop Carroll High School expects that all students will be in complete uniform at all times. Students are to be neat and well groomed at all times as well.

Students are expected to come to school dressed for school. Archbishop Carroll students will be required to come and leave school with their shirts tucked into their pants and skirts any time they are on school property. Any student who chooses not to comply will be in direct violation of the uniform policy.

### FALL & SPRING UNIFORM

The Fall / Spring uniform is worn from the beginning of the school year through Nov. 4 and from first day after spring break through end of the school year.

#### Girls (9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup>):

- Herringbone (year round) or green knee-length skirt
- Graphite gray monogrammed slacks
- Carroll polo shirt, white or green
- Oxford shirt, long or short sleeve, white
  - If a t-shirt is worn under the oxford, it must be plain black or white with no writing, designs, or pictures on it.
- Belt – black or brown
- Tights/stockings: design free, neutral skin tones, black, forest green, or white
- Black athletic shoes (no colored logos, etc.) or black/brown flat-heeled dress shoes
- 9-11 girls option: School blazer
- Senior girls options:
  - Archbishop Carroll dress sweatshirt
  - Sweater (v-neck long sleeve, v-neck sleeveless, or cardigan)

#### Boys (9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup>):

- Graphite gray monogrammed slacks
- Carroll polo shirt, white or green
- Oxford shirt, long or short sleeve, white
  - If a t-shirt is worn under the oxford, it must be plain black or white with no writing, designs, or pictures on it.
  - Young men who wear the oxford shirt at any time of year must wear the uniform tie (green and gold stripe underclassmen/gold seniors)
- Belt – black or brown

- Black athletic shoe (no colored logos, etc.) or black or brown dress shoes
- 9-11 boys option: School blazer
- Senior Boys options:
  - Archbishop Carroll dress sweatshirt
  - Sweater (v-neck long sleeve, v-neck sleeveless, or cardigan)

### WINTER UNIFORM

Winter: The winter uniform is worn from Nov. 5 until last day before spring break.

#### Girls (9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup>):

- Herringbone skirt
- Graphite gray monogrammed slacks
- Oxford shirt, long or short sleeve, white
  - If a t-shirt is worn under the oxford, it must be plain black or white with no writing, designs, or pictures on it.
- Uniform blazer
- Belt – black or brown
- Tights/stockings: design free, neutral skin tones, black, forest green, or white
- Black athletic shoes (no colored logos, etc.) or black/brown flat-heeled dress shoes
- Senior girl options:
  - Archbishop Carroll dress sweatshirt
  - Sweater (v-neck long sleeve, v-neck sleeveless, cardigan)

#### Boys (9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup>):

- Graphite gray monogrammed pant
- Oxford shirt, long or short sleeve, white
  - If a t-shirt is worn under the oxford, it must be plain black or white with no writing, designs, or pictures on it.
- Uniform tie: underclassmen—green and gold stripe; seniors--gold
- Uniform blazer
- Belts – black or brown
- Black athletic shoes (no colored logos, etc.) or black/brown flat heeled dress shoes
- Senior Boys options:
  - Archbishop Carroll dress sweatshirt
  - Sweater (v-neck long sleeve, v-neck sleeveless, cardigan)

## **HAIR POLICY**

Archbishop Carroll High School students are to be neat and well groomed at all times. Braids and similar hairstyles are acceptable for young men and women if the hairstyle is neat and well-kept.

The administration reserves the right to disallow any hair style, male or female, that is inconsistent with Archbishop Carroll High School's standards of appearance.

Students who violate this policy will receive a demerit. Repeat offenders will receive administrative detention and face possible suspension from school.

## **HAIR ACCESSORIES**

Hats, skullcaps, bandannas, and the like are not permitted. Hair accessories must be moderate and non-distracting. The only acceptable colors are those that represent the color of the uniform, black, or brown.

Jewelry is to be of moderate size and amount. Earrings, one pair, must be no larger than a quarter. Males are not permitted to wear earrings with the school uniform. Nose rings and tongue rings are not permitted for male or females.

## **OUT-OF-UNIFORM DAYS**

On out-of-uniform days, students are expected to dress modestly and in good taste. Students who do not will be required by an administrator to change.

- No clothing such as see-through garments, halters or tube tops, or any type of revealing or sloppy clothing.
- No shorts or hats are to be worn in the building at any time (male or female).
- No shirts or blouses with inappropriate writings or pictures.
- No mini skirts or tight-fitting or revealing clothing.
- No clothing with rips, holes, or tears.
- No spandex clothing such as tights or leggings.
- No skin-tight slacks or jeans.

## **ATTIRE DURING EXAMS**

Students must be attired in complete uniform when taking semester and final exams. Students in violation will not be permitted to take exams and will be sent home. Students will be allowed to take exams missed on make-up exam days as determined by the vice principal for academic affairs.
