Semester courses earn 0.5 credit and year courses typically earn 1.0 credit. The school reserves the right to decide which courses will be offered during a particular school year. That decision will be based on student course requests and needs, as well as staffing. A course not selected by at least fifteen students may not be offered.

New Courses in 2011-12

- Drama has been added as an elective.
- Students may now choose to take dance instead of P.E..
- Students may now take Yearbook as an elective course for one or two semesters.
- Sophomores are strongly encouraged to choose Math Problem Solving and Test Prep, formerly Geometry Lab, although it is no longer a required course for all students. Some students may be required to take it on the recommendation of their math instructor.
- Archbishop Carroll's sophomore religion course has been changed to reflect the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops' Framework, under the guidance of the expectations of the Archdiocese of Washington.
